Interplast Australia & New Zealand sends teams of volunteer surgeons, anaesthetists, nurses and allied therapists to developing countries in the Asia Pacific region to provide programs of free treatment and training.

Interplast provide treatment for conditions such as cleft lip and palate repair and release of burns scar contractures, and training and mentoring programs in the area of plastic and reconstructive surgery, burns management, hand surgery and therapy, occupational and speech therapy.

Since foundation in 1983 Interplast volunteers have

- Trained hundreds of overseas medical personnel
- Sponsored over 70 doctors and nurses to receive training in Australia
- Sent over 600 volunteers
- On over 400 programs
- To 23 countries
- Conducted nearly 30,000 consultations, and
- Performed 18,000 life changing operations

Some of Interplast's other achievements include

- Development of a Laos Cleft Team that now train their own colleagues and perform their own outreach programs.
- Assistance in the development of Burma's first post graduate plastic and reconstructive surgery training program.
- Assistance in the development of Indonesia's plastic and reconstructive surgery post graduate training program.
- Delivered microsurgery training modules in recipient countries, where surgeons are now performing successful procedures.
- Together with ANZBA commenced training and established a faculty for the treatment of Early Management of Severe Burns (EMSB) in Papua New Guinea, Bangladesh and soon Tonga.

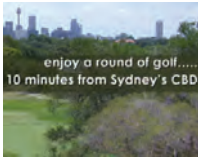

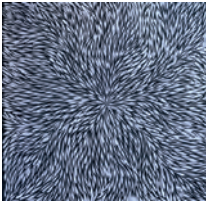
